Climate Control



The system – how does it work?

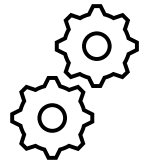
Our apartments are heated in winter & cooled in summer by an inverter-controlled air/water pump.



The temperature in our apartments is regulated by a floor system through which we run warm water in winter to heat and cold water in summer to cool the accommodation.

Temperature regulation

The room temperature can be set with the control panel that is installed in each living- & bedroom.



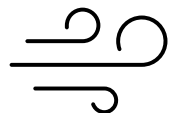
The maximum temperature is 24 degrees.

The system can only warm or cool all apartments, not heat one and cool the other as they are connected to one another.

Please mind that this is a sustainable, yet not fast way to regulate the climate in our accommodations. Therefore it is important to not expect heat to come to your room quick by turning up the temperature on the control panel.

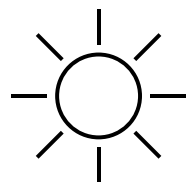
Ventilation by opening windows

Of course it is important to ventilate your apartment, also in wintertime, but please be aware that it might take a while to get the temperature up again. This goes the other way in summer. Once the heat has entered your apartment, it will take time to get it cool again.



Sunscreens

All A side apartments, located on the South side, have sunscreens on the outside that can be let down or pulled up, from inside the apartment. Please do keep them down as much as possible in summertime, to keep the sun off your windows and the temperature cool inside. Please pull them up when there is a lot of wind or storm coming.



As B side is located on the Northside sunscreens are unnecessary and are therefore not installed.
